

Headwaters Softball League Meeting

April 22, 2014

Secretary's Report – Lynn read the minutes from the March 18th meeting. Greg Peltier motioned to approve the minutes. Mike Boetcher seconded the motion, which carried.

Treasurer's Report – No treasurer's report was presented. Greg Peltier stated that he was concerned about where the league was financially. Erin stated that everything is on paper right now. Greg stated that he would work with Erin to get everything from 2013 into a spreadsheet.

Old Business

We Decide Youth Group – The We Decide Youth Group was present and showed the group the sign they created for the fields.

Moving Womens team to Tuesday nights with Over 35 League – Greg Peltier motioned to leave the womens league on Thursday nights. Jordan Eischens seconded the motion, which carried.

Moving Co-Ed team to Monday night – It was decided that the Co-Ed league would remain on Friday nights.

League Fee Reduction – The board proposed to the group lowering the league fees from \$450 to \$350 in the hopes of enticing new teams to join the league. Erin Rhodes motioned to approve lowering the league fees to \$350 but keeping the players fees at the same amounts. Theresa Quinn seconded the motion, which carried.

1099 Umpires – After discussion from the group it was decided that since the umpires are paid through the Umpire Association that the league would not 1099 them.

New Business

Ryan Eischens stated that there was no additional funds coming from the city for any park needs in 2014. He would work with the city to get funds for the 2015 season.

Ryan stated that the sprinkler system needs work and repair this year. He will work to get that fixed.

Ryan stated that a faucet in the concessions broke and he has a plumber coming to fix it and check all the bathrooms. Lynn suggested replacing a few toilets as well.

It was noted that 52 Core Evols were the softballs to be used for the 2014 season.

Greg Peltier asked whether players 50+ would be able to use a different bat. It was decided to adhere to the ASA rules regarding bats.
